

LEN UMANOFF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Florida Polygraph Association (FPA) sponsors an annual educational scholarship award to a deserving and qualified graduating high school senior or a student currently attending college or other educational institution of higher learning.

This scholarship may be awarded annually by the Florida Polygraph Association. Selection committee members consist of the current Officers and Board of Directors of the FPA. The FPA Officers and the Board of Directors shall determine funding for this scholarship program. If the submitting applicant is a dependent of the selection committee member, said member will not act in the selection process.

The submitting applicant must be a dependent child, under the age of twenty-three (23) and at least one parent must be a full member in good standing of the FPA. The applicant may also be the grandchild, niece or nephew of a member in good standing. If the said member is deceased, the member must have been in good standing with the FPA at the time of death.

Requests for applications will be made to the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee. The application must be completed and returned with all of the required documents to the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee no later than **May 1st** of the year in which the applicant applies. The Chairperson will present all completed applications to the Selection Committee for evaluation during the FPA's scheduled Board meeting prior to the spring seminar. Applications will be reviewed for the need of financial assistance, their goals and objectives for the future, their community involvement as well as their scholastic achievement. Recipient(s) of the scholarship will be announced at the spring seminar. The student's name(s) will be published in the following FPA Polygram Newsletter.

The applicant must:

- 1) Complete the attached application
- 2) Submit with this application an official transcript of all courses and grades received throughout high school or other educational institution most recently attended
- 3) Provide with this application two (2) character reference letters, once (1) from your current or most recently attended institution's faculty and one (1) from a non-relative
- 4) Provide one (1) passport sized photo
