# Certified Polygraphists "CP" Guide

### **Requirements:**

- 1. Current or Life FPA Member in good standing (Dues up to date)
- 2. Must adhere to FPA/APA validated techniques in all polygraph practices
- 3. Abide by FPA Standards and Principles of Practice
- 4. Four (4) years of experience as a Polygraphist
- 5. Completed **FOUR (4)** Seminars for **NINETY-SIX (96) Hours** at the **FPA** Randall Jones School for Continuing Studies.
  - a. Must have received the Certificate of Attendance from said Seminars
- 6. Must apply for this designation, in writing and notarized

#### **Issuance:**

- 1. Reviewed by the school director
- 2. Approved by the board of directors
- 3. Good for FIVE (5) years beginning after approval

## **Renewals:**

- 1. Remains a member of the FPA in good standing
- 2. Attends **SEVENTY-TWO (72) hours** of FPA approved training within five (5) years from issuance and/or last renewal
  - a. FIFTY-SIX (56) hours must be training from FPA Seminars
  - b. SIXTEEN (16) hours may be from outside the FPA. It must be an approved state, national, government agency or association, and/or advanced training from an APA approved polygraph school.
  - c. Outside training must be submitted to and approved by the Director of the Randall Jones School for Continuing Studies.
  - d. Members must provide documentation of attendance for outside training.
- 3. Member must provide documented evidence of attendance of FPA Seminars

# **Suspension:**

- 1. Member's certification may be suspended or revoked by the FPA Board for good and sufficient reasons.
- 2. Upon notice of suspension/revocation, member must promptly return the certificate to the school director.
